UNAPPROVED REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 25, 2018**

Pursuant to public notice, Chairman David Floyd convened a regular meeting of the Sustainability Board on Wednesday, April 25, 2018, at 7:03 p.m., in the Council Chamber. Board Members present were David Vigliotti, Nick Inbornone, Kristopher Reid, John Fergus, Matt White, Mark Boyd and Steven Gillem. Staff Members present were Environmental Coordinator Nick Sanzone.

Chairman David Floyd led the Pledge of Allegiance.

(TIME: 7:07 P.M.) PUBLIC COMMENT

Carol Robitschek thanked the Board for help with the Library landscaping. Terry Mott presented a plant for Earth Day and for leadership in sustainability. Karen Wade spoke about reducing single use plastic bags and straws. Rodney Smith suggested making compost accessible for the community garden.

(TIME: 7:25 P.M.) STAFF UPDATE

Nick talked about working with Publix to get vegetables to compost, the planting day and Earth Day events.

(TIME: 7:39 P.M.) DISCUSS/TAKE ACTION ON NATIVE LANDSCAPING

Nick talked about the new Beautification Board criteria for yard of the month program and propagating more native plants.

Public Comment: Rodney Smith asked about the swales at the Library.

ACTION: Board Member Reid MOVED, SECOND by Board Member Mark Boyd to add on to the City Garden to grow native plants. VOTE: 7 YES, 1 NO (White). MOTION CARRIED.

Kristopher Reid talked about getting coasters made to reduce straws in local restaurants, and his research on price points and design. There was discussion on partnering with larger companies and suppliers to reduce straws as well.
