

Attire

It is important for students to wear appropriate clothes for dance. The main purpose for this is to enable the instructor to see the proper body alignment. Also simplicity of dress is less distracting. Proper attire is required within the first month of registering. Please mark all shoes and dance bags with the child's name.

Past recital costumes, tutus, long ballet skirts, and jeans are not allowed. To ensure proper fit, students can purchase shoes at Melbourne Dancewear, 442 N. Harbor City Blvd, Melbourne, one block north of Dell's Freeze, phone 259-9922 or any store specializing in dance wear.

Used shoes can be purchased from the instructor when available.

BOY's attire includes a t-shirt and dance pants or shorts.
