Sec. 18-1. State of emergency; proclamation; authority of mayor.

Whenever any riot or mob violence has occurred, or there is reasonable cause to apprehend an outbreak thereof within the city, or in the vicinity thereof, the mayor shall have and is hereby vested with the power to immediately issue a proclamation declaring a state of emergency pursuant to F.S. § 870.041. The mayor shall have the authority to exercise the powers conferred in F.S. § 870.041 et seq.
