Sec. 6-1. Drinking on city property.

No person shall drink, consume, dispense or sell alcoholic beverages on any street, sidewalk or other property of the city except at the Civic Center, the David R. Schechter Community Center, or Samsons Island during activities for which a permit was issued by the recreation department and in conformance with applicable rules and regulations.

Sec. 6-2. Hours of sale.

Alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed or served or permitted to be sold, consumed or served in any establishment within the city from 7:00 a.m. each day until 2:00 a.m. the following day.
