

**MINUTES  
PUBLIC HEARING  
SEPTEMBER 3, 2008**

Pursuant to Public Notice, Mayor Brimer convened a Public Hearing on Wednesday, September 3, 2008, at 6:30 p.m., in the Council Chamber. Those present were Mayor Mark Brimer, Vice-Mayor Joseph Ferrante, Councilman Dominick Montanaro, Councilwoman Martha Kirby, Councilman Sal D'Amato, City Manager Michael P. Crotty, and City Clerk Barbara Montanaro.

The sole purpose of the public hearing was to advertise and give public notice of the City's intention to submit a grant application to the Florida Recreation Department Assistance Program Grant to construct a playground (play deck and other features), two picnic facilities (slabs and tables), a hiking trail with ocean view, a covered deck overlooking the ocean, an outdoor shower adjacent to the beach access path, benches, bike racks, trash receptacles at the Satellite Beach Gemini Park. The project will also include the following renovations: upgrade the existing saltwater beach access by [1] expanding the path and replacing its deteriorated asphalt with an ADA-compliant concrete surface and [2] expanding the dune crossover and replacing its steps with a ramp; install a slab and new table for existing picnic facility; and expand and upgrade the park's landscaping.

This park has been designed to be low maintenance and provides a community walk/bike-to family recreational area.

Mayor Brimer opened the PUBLIC HEARING and invited comments.

There were no comments.

Council concurred that this is a project that is beneficial to the community and recommended that the grant application and supporting resolution be considered at the following regular Council meeting.

Mayor Brimer adjourned the public hearing at 6:40 p.m.
